

anyone say that any of the things he possessed was his own, but they had all things in common. 33 And with great power the apostles gave witness to the resurrection of the Lord Jesus. And great grace was upon them all.

From this first century example of being of one heart and one soul, we understand why the Apostle Paul made such an appeal to the Philippian brethren: *Philippians 2:1 Therefore if there is any consolation in Christ, if any comfort of love, if any fellowship of the Spirit, if any affection and mercy, 2 fulfill my joy by being like-minded, having the same love, being of one accord, of one mind. 3 Let nothing be done through selfish ambition or conceit, but in lowliness of mind let each esteem others better than himself. 4 Let each of you look out not only for his own interests, but also for the interests of others. In the one body of Christ, we are challenged to look out for the interests of others without respect to ancestry, history or skin color. We share in the same love one for another.*

The gospel provides the answer for a world of sin. (Acts 22:16) Are you one in Christ? Have you obeyed from the heart the plain and simple gospel plan of Salvation? Isn't it wonderful that even "hillbillies" like me can obey the truth and receive the forgiveness of sins? How about y'all? How ya doin' spiritually?

All One in Christ

Ephesian 3:26 For you are all sons of God through faith in Christ Jesus. 27 For as many of you as were baptized into Christ have put on Christ. 28 There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither slave nor free, there is neither male nor female; for you are all one in Christ Jesus. 29 And if you are Christ's, then you are Abraham's seed, and heirs according to the promise.

There is a story of a Bible class teacher who was carefully explaining to her young students how that Christ died for all and that it didn't matter whether male or female, boy or girl, Jew or of another race, or if people had a special color of skin as long as we have put on Christ. As she was expounding, a very young lady jumped up and very emphatically said that she only liked colored people! The teacher was a bit puzzled and asked her why she only liked colored people? The young student spoke plainly, "Well, my daddy, he likes to mostly watch black and white people but I prefer colored people!" By now the teacher is a bit amused and asked the girl to explain. The girl put it simply, "My daddy likes to watch black and white cowboy shows but I don't like them, I prefer to see the colored people on tv and especially color cartoons that my momma and I watch."



As Cathy and I have had a chance to visit with members of the congregation, it is so interesting to learn about other's heritage and history. It is fascinating see how we come from different places around the country and from different backgrounds with different ancestries and histories. My grandfather's mother was a full blooded Oklahoma Indian and yet, culturally, we have little connection to our American Indian heritage.
