Jesus uses that is translated "marvel" has the meaning of being astonished out of one's senses; awestruck, "wondering very greatly" (Souter). Clearly, being born again was a concept that Nicodemus was having difficulty grasping. The scripture says that "Nicodemus answered and said to Him, 'How can these things be?'" John 3:9.

A fuller understanding of the new birth would come after Jesus died on the cross (Matt. 26:28). The apostles preached faith, repentance and a new birth: baptism for the remission of sins (Acts 2:38). The apostle Paul would explain how the new birth is possible! He explained in detail that through baptism we are buried with Christ and then raised to walk in newness of life with the old man of sin being crucified (Romans 6:1-6). The amazing aspect of baptism is that when it comes to our sins, it is like pushing the rewind or back button. We are born again free from the stains of sin, as a newborn baby in Christ. Then for the Christian, repentance and forgiveness are always available in Christ. Is it time for the rewind (rebirth) in your life?

THE REWIND BUTTON

There was a man of the Pharisees named Nicodemus, a ruler of the Jews. 2 This man came to Jesus by night and said to Him, "Rabbi, we know that You are a teacher come from God; for no one can do these signs that You do unless God is with him." 3 Jesus answered and said to him, "Most assuredly, I say to you, unless one is born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God." 4 Nicodemus said to Him, "How can a man be born when he is old? Can he enter a second time into his mother's womb and be born?" John 3:1-4

One of the things I have made good use of through the years is a rewind button. I remember when Cathy and I bought our first VCR (Video Cassette Recorder). We could record up to 4 hours of cartoons for our kids on one video tape . That meant if we needed some longed for peace and quiet, it could be cartoon time any

time. And if our girls wanted to see a cartoon over again, all we had to do was push the rewind button! Even today, I really enjoy the rewind button when playing CDs or an MP3



player. If we want to hear a song again, we push the back button and in almost an instant we hear the song.

I have often wished that life had a rewind or back button. I think. would it not be wonderful to be able to go back and enjoy time with our kids when they were young and Dad was their favorite past time? Would it not be wonderful to simply push the back button and say or do something a different way? Most would agree, a rewind button on life would surely be handy to take care of a lot of regrets and mistakes in life. But how can we reverse time?

First century Nicodemus recognized that time cannot be reversed. This is why he questioned Jesus about being born again. He asks how it is possible to be born again. Obviously, a grown man cannot enter a second time into his mother's womb and be born! And he knew it was not possible to go back or rewind to the time of birth.

But Jesus responds to Nicodemus and says, "Most assuredly, I say to you, unless one is born of water and the Spirit, he cannot enter the kingdom of God" John 3:5. And then Jesus declares emphatically, "Do not marvel that I said to you, 'You must be **born again**" John 3:7. The word that Continued on p. 4
