Testament Christians are the one body of Christ (I Corinthians 12:13). We do not have a choice of flavors. We are given one doctrine and are all to have the same mind, all teaching the same thing. Paul warned the church that division is contrary to the truth. "I appeal to you, brothers, to watch out for those who cause divisions and create obstacles contrary to the doctrine that you have been taught; avoid them" (Romans 16:17). While some believe having a buffet of choices appeals to more people, God never created the church to be a variety banquet for mass appeal. However, the inspired writers warned that a variety of cake slices spiritually would be a reality. Paul told Timothy, "For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine, but according to their own desires, because they have itching ears, they will heap up for themselves teachers; and they will turn their ears away from the truth (II Timothy 4:2-4).

I am thankful when I have the choice of chocolate cake and I am also thankful that there is only one choice when it comes to the church. That choice is made for us when we choose Christ!! (Acts 2:38-47).

The Church Is Not Cake

He brought me to the banqueting house, and his banner over me was love. Sustain me with cakes of raisins, refresh me with apples, for I am lovesick. Song of Solomon 2:4-5

When you attend weddings you have both beautiful brides and beautiful cakes. During last Sunday's wedding reception, I was really happy that I could



select a piece of chocolate cake from a banquet of delightful cakes. It is amazing to learn of all the work that goes into preparing beautiful cakes, especially the multitiered wedding cakes with their very ornate decorations. What is also very amazing is that the cakes are never designed nor made to be whole or stay complete as one. Despite all the work, cakes are baked and decorated to be cut into pieces for the enjoyment of the partakers.

We can love and enjoy eating cake, but we must know that the church is not cake!! As far as we know, Jesus never baked a cake, not even cakes of raisins, but he did build his church (Matthew 16:18). It is a beautiful church designed to be as beautiful as a bride adorned for her husband. Christ loved the church as a bride and willingly gave himself up for her! (Ephesians 5:25) However, the common notion among many who call themselves "Christians" is that the church is like a wedding cake. It is designed to be cut up into pieces. This concept is known as denominationalism. The notion is that all denominations are simply a part of the whole and thus acceptable to God. Christ did not mix ingredients and then bake a cake to be cut into pieces! Paul explains that Christ is the head of the church which is his body. He distinctly declares by the Spirit of God that there is one body! (Ephesians 4:4) That body, the one church, was not designed and built to be cut into pieces. In fact, scripture speaks four times using the words "whole church" (Acts 5:11, Acts 15:22, Romans 16:23, I Corinthians 14:23). Paul states emphatically the church of Christ is to remain whole. "I appeal to you, brothers, by the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that all of you agree, and that there be no divisions among you, but that you be united in the same mind and the same judgment" (I Corinthians 1:10).

If you were to banquet at the Golden Corral this afternoon, you would likely find several different types of cakes all cut up into slices. For those of us who love chocolate cake, likely it is there. If you prefer carrot cake, likely it is there. If you like coconut cake, likely it is there. Take your pick. Pick the cake of your choice. Tragically, many religious people see the denominational world as just different types of cake so that folks can pick out the flavor they would enjoy the most. This is why you will hear people say, "Just choose the church of your choice." However, the concept of the church being divided into different pieces with many different flavors and kinds is not taught in the New Testament. Neither Christ, the Apostles nor the inspired New Testament writers ever taught that we are to choose the church of our choice. Christ gave us one whole choice, and that was to choose his church. Thus, New
