### In Just One Week: The Eighth Day

Nehemiah 8:17 ... And there was very great gladness. 18 Also day by day, from the first day until the last day, he read from the Book of the Law of God. And they kept the feast seven days; and on the eighth day there was a sacred assembly, according to the prescribed manner.

Counting today as the first day, the eighth day will be May 5th. Lord willing, on this eighth day, we will once again gather for a sacred assembly to worship before the Lord. Additionally, we will see the fruits of our efforts to go "ALL OUT" in inviting people to be with us to hear words read from the book that contains the word of God. We are praying that many friends and family will join us to worship God and to hear a message that has been prepared to touch the lives of those who listen. Cornelius was instructed to send men for Peter "who will tell you words by which you and all your household will be saved" (Acts 11:14). What words have this power except the true words of inspiration from the book of God?

We have just a few days remaining to reach out and invite our family and friends to attend.
