would say she is perfect in all her ways, but in imperfection, a godly mother is to be praised and honored. It is no wonder that in a little town in Taylor County, West Virginia, Anna Jarvis, in 1907, began a campaign to establish a national Mother's Day. The special day would fall on the anniversary of her mother's death. So on May 10, 1908 the day was observed in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania where Anna Jarvis had recently moved. It wasn't until 1914 that President Woodrow Wilson made the official announcement to the nation that every second Sunday of May would be a national day of observance.

"Honor your father and mother, which is the first commandment with promise: that it may be well with you and you may live long on the earth." Ephesians 6:2-3
